<u>ANNUAL REPORT – 2022-23</u>

I am happy to present the annual report at the 23nd school day celebration of our school, to appraise you of the mission and philosophy that M.S.S. Public School has materialised positively, in the day to day working and achieving excellence in the field of education. The School, owned and managed by M.S.S, started functioning in 2000. There are 1121 students, 54 teaching staff and 20 non teaching staff on the roll. Apart from preparing children to qualify for purely academic demands, special efforts are being made, continuously to enable them to face the challenges of the competitive world.

Along with imparting education to match the advancement in technology and globalization, we lead our children ahead with the ethics of moral values and principles upheld by M.S.S. We endeavour constantly to instill these qualities in our children. We are proud of ourselves that we help them to grow and develop into responsible citizens of the next generation. The purpose of our education is that, every student who passes through the gateway of this school learns to be a good human, showing plenty of concern for the need of our nation. Many changes happened in the school, this year, in terms of expectations, communication, behaviour management, professional development, technology, and above all, academic activities.

ACADEMICS

Our students maintain very good standard in academics. Though we are following a holistic approach towards education, we are giving due importance to academics. For the 18th time we got 100% in class X and XII exams continuously with high scores. Our students performed excellently in various entrance examinations like JEE and NEET. They performed well in various competitive exams

also. The education system introduced by CBSE aims at the overall development of the children, emphasizing the need of a stress free, student friendly methodology of teaching. We try our level best to stick on this idea of teaching-learning process. We are always trying to create a child friendly and parent friendly atmosphere in the school. We are giving importance to environmental protection, energy conservation and charity through which students become socially responsible persons.

Pre and Post midterm exams and Midterm exams are conducted on time and progress reports are presented to parents in open houses. Nowadays, co-curricular activities are part of the curriculum and there is evaluation for them also. Remedial classes & special classes were arranged in regular school hours, for those who are in need of special attention. Special coaching class at night is also arranged for the Xth & XIIth students as a part of learning festival.

Fresher's day celebration for KG students was conducted, which welcomed them to a new atmosphere and made them happy and comfortable by giving balls and other gifts.

As a part of World Bicycle Day, an initiative was taken to motivate students to use bicycle for transportation whereby we can decrease the pollution. On June 3rd sweets were given to the students who came to school by cycle daily as a token of appreciation. A cycle rally was also conducted on the same day.

As part of environment day celebration on 5th June, 35 students along with teachers who are members of green club went on a study trip to V M K Botanical Garden, started by V. Muhammed Koya Vanamitra award winner. Students performed a dance invoking the goodness of nature. A dance sculpture was organised by the students.

School election was conducted on June 14th and Mithil Mohan of XIIth std was elected as the school Head boy and Iman Firoz of XIIth std was elected as the school Head girl. Investiture Ceremony was conducted on the next day.

As part of reading week celebration Vayalar's poem "Ravanaputhri" was screened in the assembly. Various programmes were conducted whereby students were made aware of the importance of reading. Famous writer Mr Banna Chennamangulure handled story telling session. It was highly motivating and children enjoyed a lot.

Carrier Guidance classes for students of class Xth & XIIth was conducted to motivate them and to take up a successful carrier and guide them in a most effective way.

A yoga class was held on June 21st, in connection with Yoga day, to make the students aware of the benefits of yoga.

Various clubs are functioning in our school. Club inauguration was done by Kozhikode sub collector V.Chelsa Sini. Students presented various programs under the guidance of science, maths, social science, literary, eco and traffic clubs. The green club members presented the guest with a non –toxic vegetable kit. The speech by the chief guest was a great motivation for the students.

On Anti Drug day M.S.S Public school students organised propaganda programs. The dance - sculpture was presented at Malikkadavu ITI and Thaneerpanthal junction. The program was organised as a part of awareness, raising against drug addiction, Students and teachers participated in the program.

On Basheer day, the female characters of Basheer were portrayed. Basheer character cartoon competition, Basheer day literature quiz and drawing competition were organized.

Green club members of M.S.S Public School conducted Karkidaka Fest. Mr Muhammed Saleem, Agricultural Officer, Puthiyara inaugurated the programme, he detailed about the importance of the month Karkidaka. In order to make them aware of the importance of leafy vegetables – a leafy veg fest was also conducted. Karkidaka kanji was prepared at school and was given to the staff members which was a different experience.

A three day residential camp for HSG Cadets was held at M.S.S. Public School. This was an advancement camp conducted for making the HSG cadets capable for moving into the next rank.

32 manuscript magazines of children from 1st – 12th std have been released, which helped to enhance the creativity of children. Prizes were distributed to the best manuscript. The magazines were released on Independence day celebration.

M.S.S. Public School fiesta (Arts Day) celebrations was conducted on August 16th & 17th Students of Ist - XIIth participated actively. The feasta was a grand success.

As a part of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav" on Chingam 1st, Farmer's Day, M.S.S Public School proposed the idea of planting a curry leaf plant at every home. As a part of this project curry leaves seedlings and seeds were distributed to students. Students also cultivated various kinds of vegetables and herbs in the school premises, such as Tapioca, Yams, Brinjal, Green chilly, Tomatoes etc. The harvest was done in several stages and the produce was sold among the employees and the public. The proceeds from the sale are used for charity.

On National sports Day a two km rally was organised at school on August 29th.

The students of M.S.S. Public School gifted umbrellas to the migrant students of Bairaikulam G.L.P School, Kozhikode as Onam gift. They were very pleased with the gift. Gunjan Suthar of 8th std who was part of this umbrella making gave an explanation regarding this in hindi to the students. 20 students of M.S.S. Public School actively participated in this. The event was done under the guidance of our craft teacher K.B Roshitha.The function was held on September 16th at Bairaikulam School and North Police Assistant Commissioner Bijuraj inaugurated the function.

Onam was celebrated grandly with various programmes. Teachers and parents gathered all the vegetables and groceries and prepared an onasadhya for 1500 people at school.

On Teacher's Day, students of plus two were allowed to perform duties as teachers with the

intention of making children, experience the sweetness and bitterness of teaching.

As a part of "Say No To Plastic" students of M.S.S. Public School distributed handmade cloth bags to the general public. In connection with Gandhi Jayanthi on 2nd October a quiz programme was conducted. The students made bags during this Onam vacation and handed those to Theeram Residence Association representative at the function held at M.S.S. Public School. P.P Nikhil Corporation councillor inaugurated the function. About 800 cloth bags were made. Bag making was done under the supervision of K.B Roshitha and K.T Shahila.

A project titled "Puthulaharikoru Vote" threw light against the ever increasing drug mafia. As a part of this Anti drug campaign, flash mob and anti drug tree was organised. Children's reaction against drug addictions were posted on the tree as a part of awareness. Mr. Mohanan Puthiyottil and ward councillor Mr Nikhil

conducted an awareness class. An election was done involving students of higher secondary section.

H.S.G Association Kerala Launched project 'Harithasree Project' at M.S.S. Public School. Shri P. Mammadkoya Vice president of M.S.S. Public School and HSG group leader Nandana. S. Nair, were gifted a seed packet as part of this project. The aim of this project is to create an awareness about the need to protect environment among the general public.

Kerala Piravi was celebrated under the presence of 'Malayala vedhi' by expressing the art forms of various districts of Kerala through dance. The mango tree in the school yard was decorated with Malayalam alphabets and proverbs.

Students of M.S.S. Public School actively participated in Malabar Sahodaya District

& State level. Students secured good grades and prizes for various items.

Children made kitchen garden as a part of encouraging them to grow kitchen gardens in their homes and take care of them. Prizes were awarded for the best kitchen project garden. As a part of promoting organic farming .Students also started "Njangalum Krishiyelekh" project. The seeds obtained from new krishi bhavan were distributed to the students as a part of this project.

A football court was built in our school using modern systems to teach the world's most popular sport, football, in its own way to children from an early age. Former international football player N.P. Pradeep inaugurated the football court and Former Mohun Bagan atheletic club player Wahid Sali, Kozhikode Sports Council President Raja Gopal and others attended as special guests. The school organised a Mini World cup

involving the students of the school welcoming 2022 world cup. A quiz programme connected to FIFA World Cup was also conducted for UP, HS and HSS section.

On the occasion of the Qatar World Cup, a music album produced by Bapu vavad and directed by Pranav Sangeeth and sung by our students was released on Youtube. It was well received by the public.

The students of the school have taken up the project of cleaning the Nayanar park on November 30th and December 10th. Over 30 students participated in volunteer activities under Eco-green club of the school. Students of HSG unit also took part in it. In the coming days, it is planned to clean the park completely and plant ornamental plants to make it a perfect garden. It is also planned to build an agricultural garden on the vacant land of the mental health care centre, Kuthiravattom.

Literary camp was organised on 6th December under the leadership of literary club of M.S.S Public School to develop writing skills among children. Kerala Sahitya Academy Award winning poet Shri P.P Sreedharan Unni, and famous writer Dr. K.G Raghunath also took classes. Nanditha Biju, student of Devagiri CMI Public school who has published her poetry collection "Arcane" interacted with our students..

Class level study tours were conducted for children's mental and emotional development.

Annual Sports meet was held on December 22nd at Physical Education ground, Calicut. Dr. S.J Shabu, Principal Government Physical Education college, Kozhikode inaugurated the sports meet.

Students organized the IT Exhibition "RESTART" in a very attractive way with many charts, working and still models with innovative ideas.

Agrifest was held at the vegetable wholesale market, Vengeri which is adjacent to the school. The students and teachers of our school performed various cultural programmes and made the fest colourful. The programme was held on 24th December 2022.

Honesty Counter was inaugurated by K.H Hafiz, Alfarukh Residential Senior Secondary School Principal on 9th January 2023. It was started at school with an intention to build honesty amongst students. The counter is equipped with the things like notebooks, umbrella, pencil, pen and other stationary items. The amount of each item is attached with it. Students can deposit the amount of the taken goods in the counter prescribed.

A project to make eco- friendly and bio based toy crafts as an alternative to modern toys that are harmful to health was launched in our school. Mrs Praseetha, Craft teacher M.S.S. Public School Vengalam, gave training to children in

making toys from coconut leaves and told them to continue making toys from waste materials. The purpose of such training is to bring the students close to nature.

Our Students visited kadalundi bird sanctuary and collected various species of mangroves and sought information from local residents to understand threats that mangroves are facing.

Production of short film called 'Meenuvinde Choonduviral' is under progress .It is to create awareness about environmental pollution, traffic violations, blood donation etc. Actors in the film are students and teachers of M.S.S. Public School.
